Portfolio Review Information

What a portfolio review achieves:

We advise a portfolio review for all applicants, but it is only mandatory for Pre-Art candidates. In all cases, the review gives us the chance to meet you, to give you feedback on your work, and to personally answer your questions about the School of Art and your future with us. The review is also an opportunity to discuss your possible application for the Wolfstein Freshman Scholarship for which all students are eligible, provided they meet the March 1, 2008 deadline.

What a portfolio should contain:

Your portfolio should contain 15-20 pieces of original work selected from one or more of the following categories: drawing, painting, printmaking, collage, mixed media, sculpture, ceramics, fiber art, jewelry, photography, film, video, and computer-generated art. We are interested in seeing what you think is your strongest work. You do not have to submit examples of a range of techniques or assignments. We want to see where your enthusiasm lies.

How to submit your portfolio:

- By Interview: You may bring your portfolio to a portfolio review and interview session, held the first Friday of each month, January through February, 2008. For possible scholarship consideration, (determined in March, 2008) CD images or DVD's of your actual work must be provided (see directions below). Please call the School of Art office at (513) 556-2962 to schedule an appointment.
- By Mail: You may send in CD images or DVD's of your actual work.
- Note about three-dimensional work: Original three-dimensional work may be brought to a portfolio review and interview session. However, it may not be mailed or dropped off and left. In such cases, it must be photographed for CD images or DVD's.

How will your portfolio be returned to you:

- If you attend a portfolio review and interview session, you must take your actual work home with you. CD images or DVDs that you leave with the interviewer will be returned to you provided they are accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped mailer.
- CD images or DVDs that are mailed in to us will be returned to you if accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped mailer.
